Please send your paper and cover page in attached files in .doc, .docx, .rtf, or .pdf format. Other formats may prevent consideration of your submission.

The deadline for *receipt* of submissions is **Friday, November 19, 2021**, but early submissions will be greatly appreciated. Commentators will be selected for some papers. You are invited to send an indication of willingness to comment (along with your current c.v.) to the email address below.
